Thundersley Themes for History





1950's to the present day.

BEFORE: Thundersley was full of meadows. The pub was a blacksmiths. There were hardly any cars or roads. Thundersley was a small village.

WHAT HAPPENED: Lots of houses and shops were built. More people had cars. Road markings were added. Old buildings were knocked down and replaced. Thundersley grew in size.

AFTER: More people live in Thundersley. There are more activities and facilities. Thundersley became a town.
