*I can begin to punctuate my sentences using a capital letter and a full stop.						
*I can use capital letters for names of people, places, days of the week and the personal pronoun 'I'.						
*I can say out loud what I am going to write about.						
*I can produce my own ideas for writing.						
*I can sequence sentences to form a short narrative						
*I can use adjectives to describe a noun						
*I can form lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place						
*I can spell many common exception words						
Greater Depth (Everything Achieved)
