The Interrelated Dimensions of Music

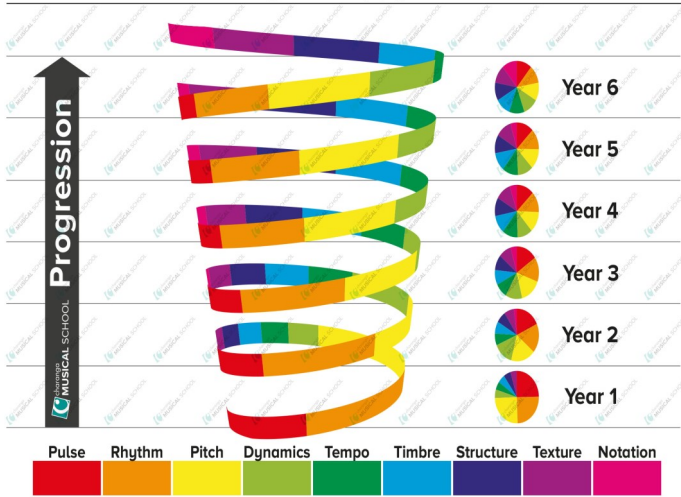
Progression through Charanga Musical School



Progression throughout the Units of Work reinforces the interrelated dimensions of music.

With each new song, always start again with the foundation of pulse, then rhythm, then pitch, adding new dimensions as you progress.

This represents an ever increasing spiral of musical learning.

I should be able to sing or sing along to nursery rhymes and action songs including: Pat-a-cake, 1,2,3,4,5 Once I caught a fish alive, This old man, Im a little teapot, Hickory Dickory Dock, Head, shoulders, knees and toes, Incy Wincy Spider, Wheels on the bus and The Hokey Cokey.

Vocabulary

- Rap** A vocal technique in which the performer speaks rhythmically against a steady beat.
- compose** Creating and developing musical ideas and 'fixing' them
- Bass Gutar** The bass guitar, electric bass or simply bass, is the lowest-pitched member of the guitar family. It is a plucked string instrument similar in appearance .

- drums**

- decks** Equipment used by DJs, MCs, and Rappers to mic sounds from different records and to make effects e.g. scratching that was first used in the late 1970s
- perform** Singing and playing instruments for others to hear.
- improvise** To make up a tune and play it on the spot. There is an assumption that it can never be recreated.

Hey You!

Hey You is written in the old School Hip Hop Style - Children will listen and appraise a variety of songs within this style. There are opportunities to clap rhythms, sing and as well as :

Playing instruments using one or two notes C or C and G

Improvise using C and G

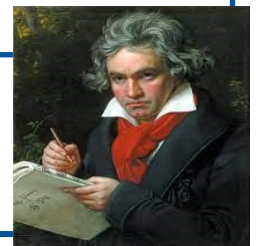
Compose using C and D or C,D and E

Rhythm in the way you walk and Banana Rap

Rhythm in the way you walk is written in a reggae style and The Banana Rap is Hip Hop

The unit ends in a performance which is to include rapping, singing and playing

**COMPOSER FOR THE TERM
LUDWIG VAN BEETHOVEN**



LUDWIG VAN BEETHOVEN - was born in Bonn, Germany, in December 1770. He learned musical composition from the official organist in a nobleman's court. Beethoven became the assistant organist at age 11 and published his first musical composition soon after. He died in 1827
