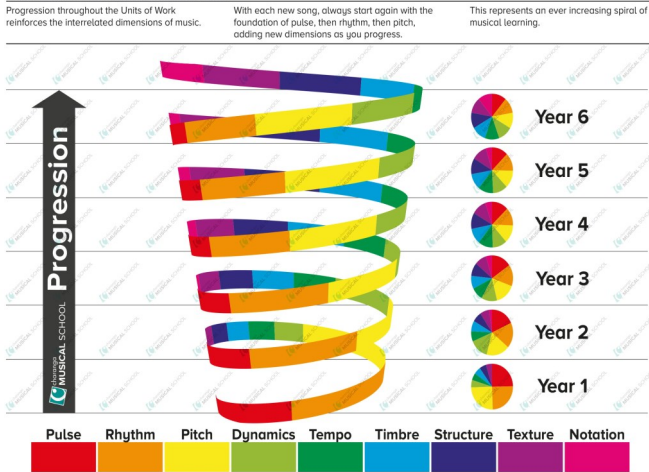


The Interrelated Dimensions of Music
