Working Towards			
*I can plan my writing and say my sentence out loud before I write it			
* My handwriting is neat and my reader can easily read what I have			
written			
* My lowercase and uppercase letters are the correct size			
I can use adjectives in my writing			
* I can use finger spaces, capital letters (including for proper nouns) and full stops			
* I can use a wider range of conjunctions such as when, if, because, although			
*I can use different sentence openers in my writing (fronted adverbials)			
* I can use ? ! and , in a list			
Working At (All Of Towards Plus Below)		 	
*I can provide enough detail to interest my reader			
I can vary the structure of my sentences to interest my reader			
*In a report I can use headings and sub-headings			
*In narrative writing I can create settings, characters and plots			
I can use expanded noun phrases (e.g. the red, shiny boat, the man on			
the moon)			
* I can begin to use paragraphs to organise my work			
*I can use adverbs and prepositions to show time and place,			
*I am beginning to use speech marks (inverted commas) in direct speech			
*I can proof read my work for spelling, grammar and punctuation errors			
I can spell some words correctly (Year 3 and 4 list)			
*I can maintain the correct tense throughout my work (past, present) and present perfect			
* I can begin to produce neat joined handwriting			
* I can accurately use apostrophes for contractions e.g. can't, won't and possession (moved from GD)			
Greater Depth (Everything Achieved)			
*I can use 'a' and 'an' correctly			
*I can write in past and present tense correctly			
* I can write neatly and join my handwriting			
*I can use paragraphs to organise ideas around a theme			
*I can spell most words correctly (Year 3 and 4 list)			
*I can use inverted commas and other punctuation to correctly
